

The **OGIA Scholarship** is presented by the OGIA Board of Directors and personally funded by Lt. Tammie Reeder (Oklahoma City Police Department) to recognize an OGIA attendee for exemplary service to their department and community. This scholarship will recognize an individual who exhibits the same dedication and mission of OGIA while combating Gang members in their communities.

This recognition will acknowledge any Officer; serving in a Gang Unit or as the Gang Officer; or officer who takes the lead in their agency with an interest in combating gangs for an agency/department with 300 or less employees.

The nomination must be submitted to include the Chief's or head of agency's approval.

Criteria documentation from first line supervisor:

1. Nominee will be working and operating Officer by OGIA's annual conference, June 2018.
2. Nominee has demonstrated extraordinary commitment to their department and community through the tracking and arrest of multiple gang members.
3. The nominee has demonstrated **any** of the following as it relates to the apprehension of gang members and arrests.

Act of Bravery and Heroism: This Scholarship recognizes an act of bravery and heroism that went above and beyond the call of duty. This would be an extraordinary act supported by documentation/video or other reliable source.

Motivation for the Vision: This Scholarship recognizes an individual for their motivation and dedication to promote gang enforcement/prevention and or intervention in attempt to reduce the gang element in their community.

Initiative and Innovation: This scholarship recognizes an individual who has demonstrated an initiative or innovation on their department and or related to the community they serve. The initiative or innovation would have marked improvement for the department or community as it relates to gang activity; is measurable and supported documentation.

Nominations must be sent to carrieogia@cox.net and received by May 7, 2018. The Scholarship will be presented at the OGIA Annual Conference in June 2018.

Evaluation of nominees will be reviewed by the OGIA Board members and voted upon by May 11, 2018.

The Scholarship will:

- Provide conference registration
- Provide maximum 3 night hotel
- The Scholarship will not exceed \$600.00 for 2018 and will cover only conference registration and hotel up \$600.00 (Meals and incidental hotel charges will not be covered and will not be the responsibility of OGIA) Arrangements for Scholarship recipient will made by OGIA Administration or designee.
